CHOSEN FOR LANDLINE BY PATRICK BOUJU

Patrick Bouju is a winemaker based in the Auvergne region of France. His labels Vivanterre — meaning “living earth” and Domaine La Bohème, translating to “Field of Bohemia” — reflect the essential qualities of their wines and winemaking: aliveness, the small-scale and handmade, a creative and collaborative process.

Organically and biodynamically farmed, vinified using natural processes, and untouched by any fining, filtering, or added sulfites, these wines directly express the unique and complex terroir of clay and limestone soil they are grown upon.

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BORDEAUX

Bordeaux, the biggest appellation in France, is divided by Gironde River and is also known as the Left Bank of Bordeaux and Right Bank of Bordeaux. 90% of the wine produced is red.

Red wines are medium to full-bodied with aromas of blackcurrant, plums and earthy notes of wet gravel. In taste they burst with mineral and fruit notes that lead into savoury, mouth-drying tannins.

Because of an abundance of tannins Bordeaux wines are able to age for several decades.

Bordeaux wines are a blend of grape varieties. Classic wines are made from Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Malbec (rarely Carmenere).

In Left Bank, with Medoc as a main area, the region is known for its graphite-driven and gravelly soils. Red wines are made here with a dominance of Cabernet Sauvignon. That makes red wines the boldest and most tannic in Bordeaux. The most prestigious sub-regions are: Pauillac, Saint-Julien, Saint Estephe or Margaux.

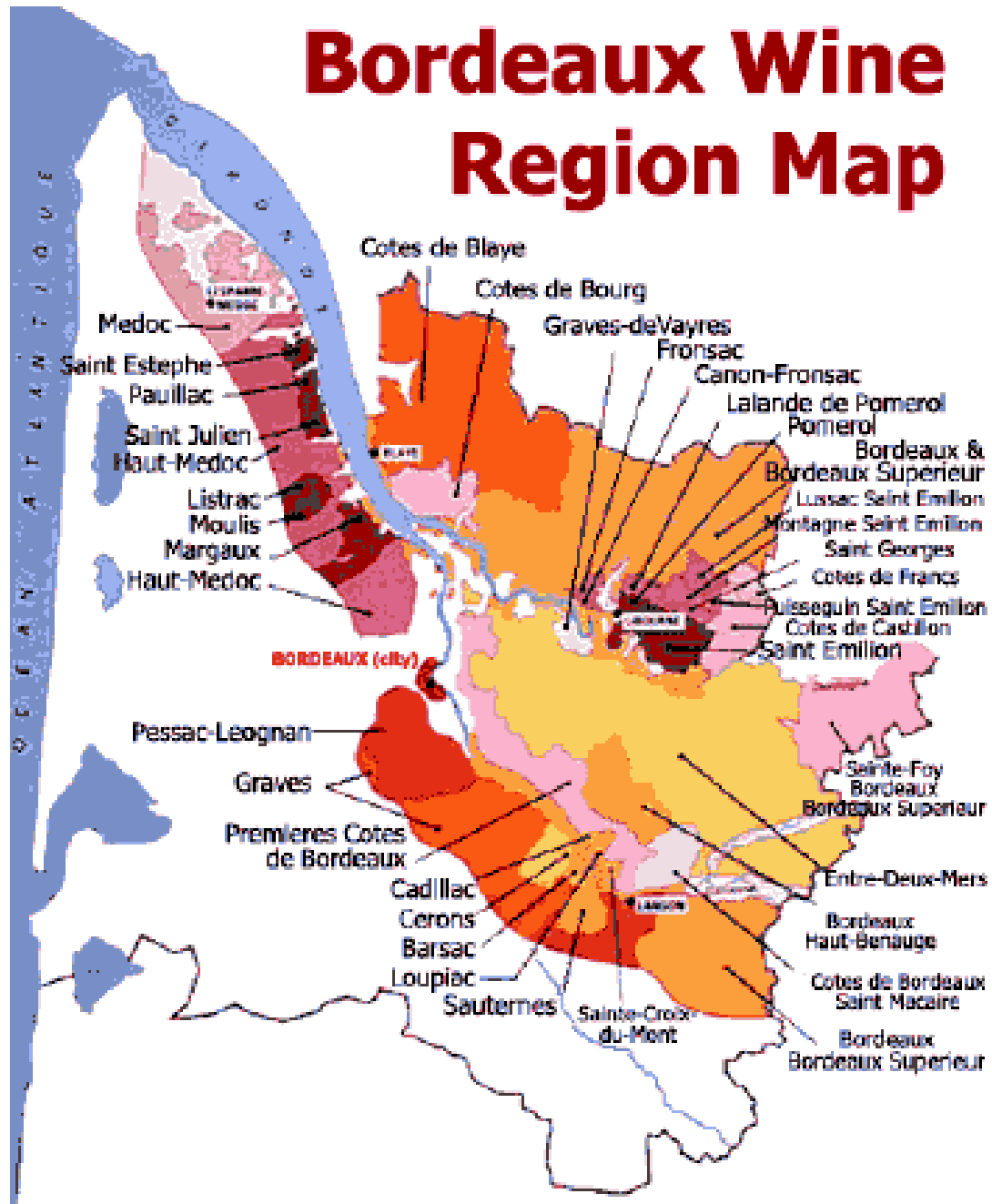
In Right Bank, the area is known for its red clay soils that produce red wines bold and plummy, softer, and with more refined tannins. Merlot is a dominant grape in this region. Pomerol and Saint-Emilion are the most known sub-regions.

The whites are mostly made from Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon grapes. Commonly dry in most areas to sweet world top class in Sauternes.

BURGUNDY

Burgundy wines are the world capital of two grapes: Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Furthest North region is known as Chablis. It's actually closer to Champagne with the same climate and soil dominant with limestone.

Chablis is well known for being a lean, unoaked Chardonnay. Due to the soil, wines from the region have beautiful purity and crispness, astonishing minerality and elegance.

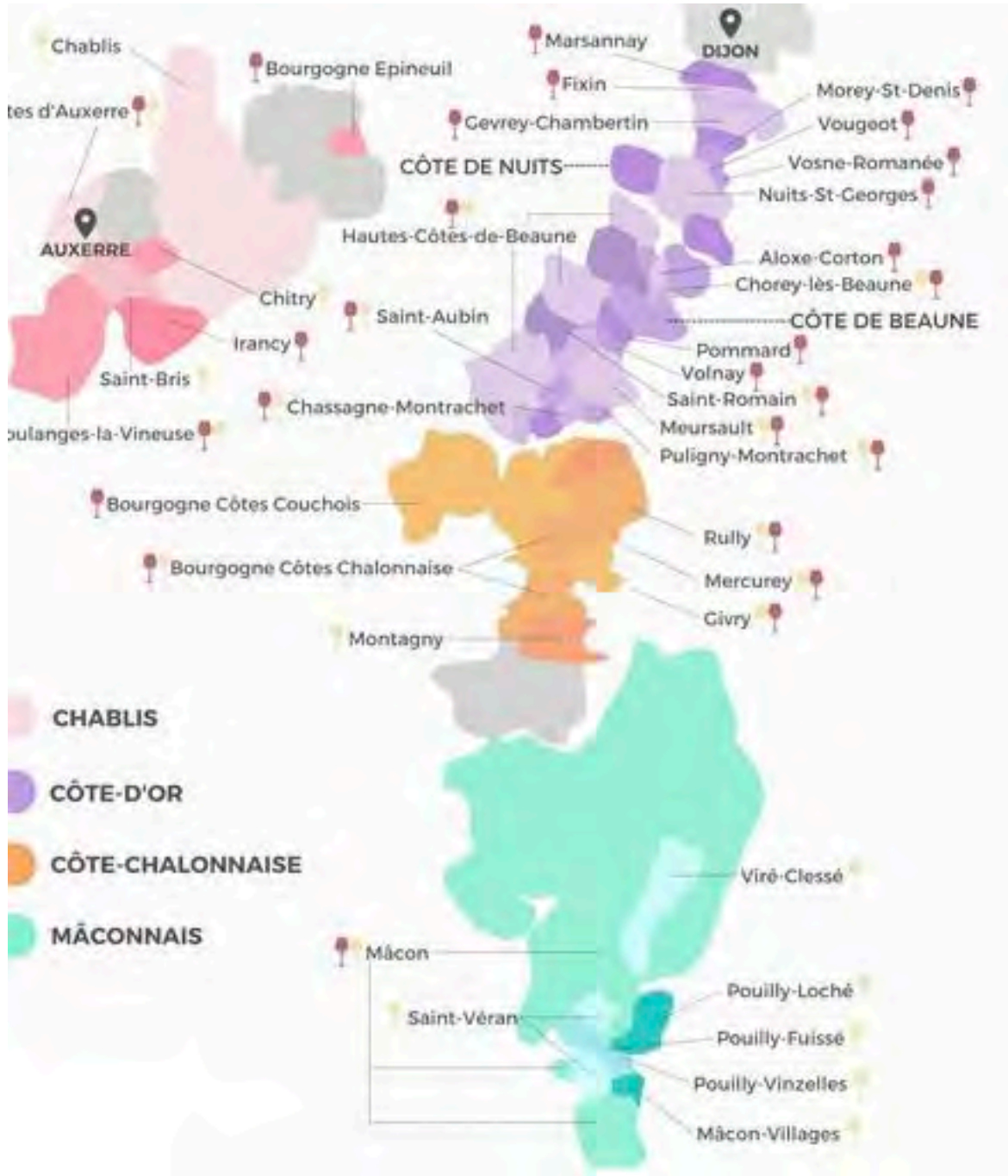
In Cote the Beaune are the world's finest Chardonnay. Wines like Meursault or Puligny Montrachet are marvellously round, creamy, oaky with nutty richness.

The best of Pinot Noir comes from Cote d'Or, the heart land of Burgundy. Flavours sweep through strawberry, raspberry and cherry in young wines to magnificent maturity of oriental spices, chocolate and truffles. Cote de Nuits is the most well-known of the biggest Pinot Noirs. Wines from the region are more full-bodied and powerful.

In the Southern region where the soil is more granitic, red wines are made from a Gamay grape. The Beaujolais is a light, fresh, aromatic and delicious to drink.

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ALSACE

On the border between France and Germany, Alsace region produces some of the most individual white wines, rich in aroma and full of ripe, distinctive flavours.

Riesling, Muscat, Gewurztraminer and Pinot Gris are generally considered the finest varieties in Alsace.

Vendange Tardive means 'late harvest'. The grapes are picked late and almost overripe, giving higher sugar levels and potentially more intense flavours.

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LOIRE

The Loire River cuts right through the heart of France. The Valley is home to over 4000 wineries that produce a dazzling array of elegant, high quality wines.

Leading appellation is Muscadet. Producing dry white wines crafted from Melon de Bourgogne grape. Muscadet is lean, minerally and best enjoyed when young and fresh.

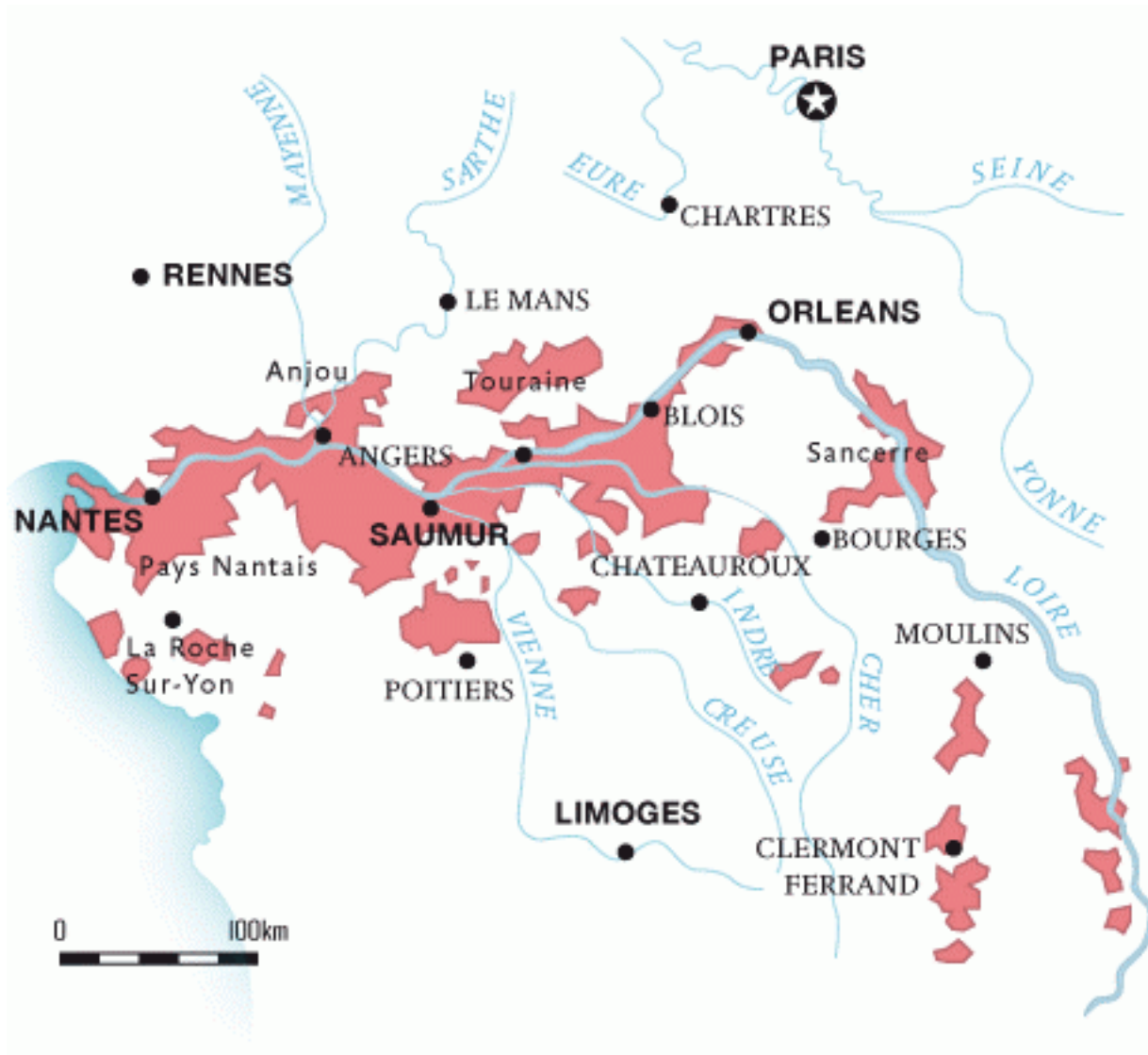
Most famous white wines from Loire are also these made from Sauvignon Blanc grape. Wines like Sancerre or Pouilly Fume are refreshing with zippy citrus, lemongrass, gooseberry with chalky minerality.

In Vouvray area, Chenin Blanc is a leading grape. The dry wines acquire beautifully rounded flavours after 6-8 years. Medium-dry wines, when well made from a single Domaine are worth aging even longer.

In Chinon, red grape Cabernet Franc with the occasional dash Of Cabernet Sauvignon is used to make lovely light wine, full of raspberry fruit.

RHÔNE VALLEY

In the northern part granite slopes overhang the river and the small amount of wine produced has remarkable individuality and great finesse. Cote-Rotie is an example. In wine Syrah grape balances full aromatic ripeness with freshness. Small amount of white grape Viognier adds exotic or violent fragrance.

The Most popular wine of Rhône Valley is Chateauneuf du Pape. The sweetly fruited, aromatic red wine is based on Grenache and Syrah. A Small number of other grapes are allowed to be added in appellation.

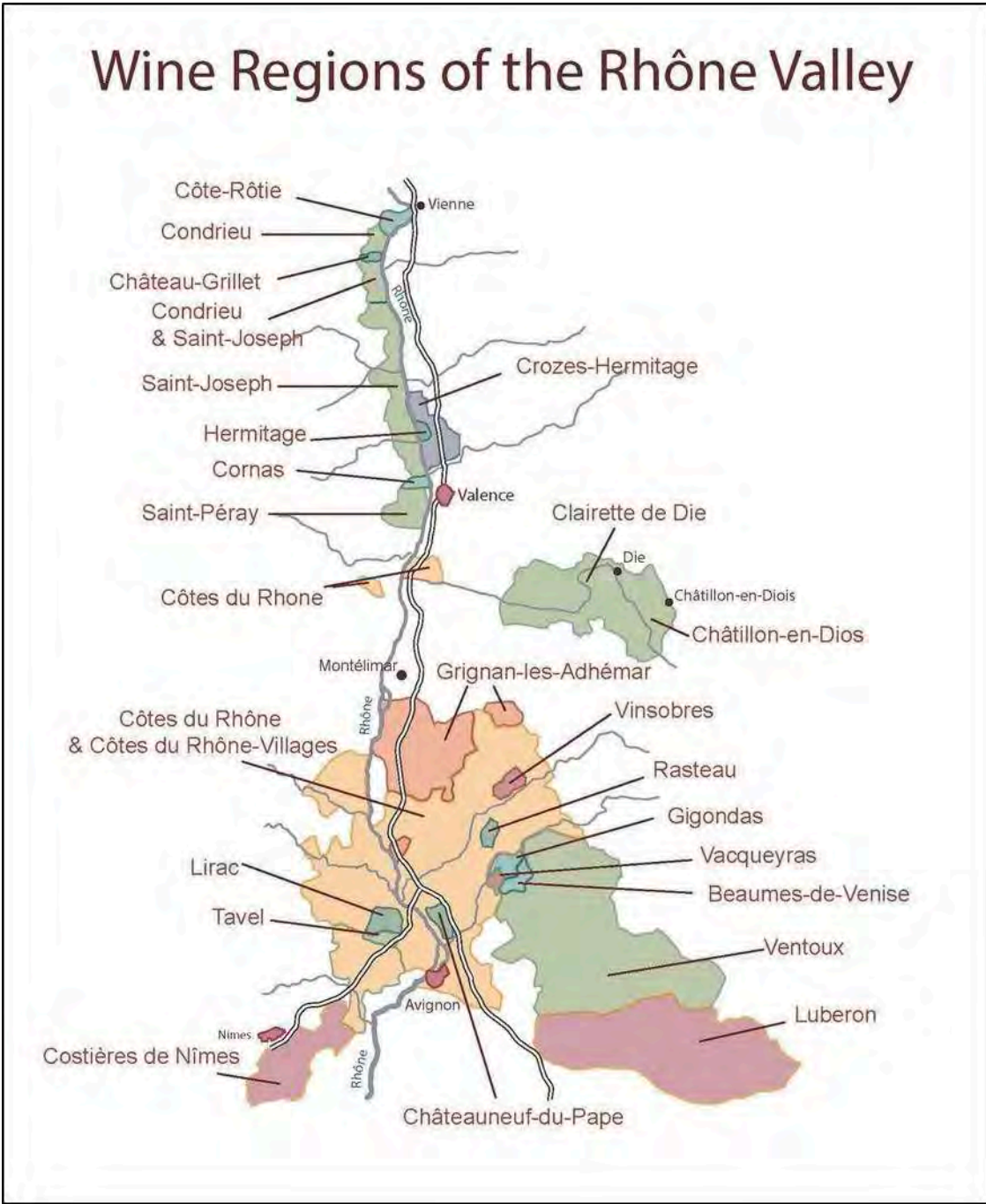
White wines made in Rhône are dry, wonderfully rich, oaky and fruity.

The South of France is situated between Provence and Languedoc-Roussillon.

The wines like Pic St-Loup, the best in Languedoc are dominant with the Syrah variety along with Grenache and Mourvèdre. Provence Bandol as example has a character from Mourvèdre which gives the wine a dense colour, smokey black fruit and herby fragrance.

GERMANY AND AUSTRIA

In Germany, the long growing season and moderate summer temperatures create wines that are relatively low in alcohol, lively and fruity.

Germany is famous mainly for the world class Riesling produced in Mosel. From bone-dry Kabinett to sweet Late harvest. Major flavours: peachy, honeyed, floral, citrusy with an interesting petrol note from ageing maturation.

Famous other German grapes like white Sylvaner or very light Pinot Noirs are becoming popular from this part of the world.

Austria successfully produces white wines with world popular- Gruner Veltliner. Wine made from this grape shows white pepper, lentil, and celery notes when youth, citrus, honey and more bodied with age.

SPAIN AND PORTUGAL

In Spain, Rioja is synonymous with wine. Region covers a large vineyard area around three prestigious communities: La Rioja, Basque Country and Navarre). The Rioja wines are the most famous of Spain and their long tradition support their fame on international markets.

Albarino is the dominate grape grown along the coast of Northwest Spain in the region named Rias Baixas. White wines made from Albarino grape are crisp and full flavoured.

Duero River Valley is the birthplace to some of the country's finest red wines like Vega Sicilia. The region is fuelled by Tempranillo, the most planted grape across the country producing bold reds.

Portuguese wines are made mostly from native grapes, occasionally blended with international varieties. The white wines mainly are crisp with notes of peach apple and citrus fruits. Reds are nicely aromatic with redfruit flavours.

The Douro region in the North is home to Port. Adding wine spirit early in the fermentation process, fortifies the wine. Unconsumed sugar makes the wine sweet. Port is made from several local grapes from the slopes of Douro River.

ITALY

The wine in Italy tends to reflect the local cuisine of its twenty administrative regions; this results in a multiplicity of styles of Italian wine. It's appreciated and sought after by wine lovers around the world. Barolo, Barbaresco and Brunello di Montalcino represents the prestigious wines of the Country.

Other notable wines that have gained attention to the international market are: Amarone della Valpolicella from Veneto or Chianti from Tuscany. Successful whites, like wines made from Cortese grape in Piedmont or Pinot Grigios from Friuli-Venezia.

The most successful sparkling wine in the world, apart from Champagne, is definitely Prosecco made from Glera grape. Most Prosecco are produced in a dry, Brut style. However, due to the grape's fruity flavours of green apple honeydew or pear, it usually seems sweeter than it is.

Australian's wine regions are mainly in the Southern, cooler parts of the Country. Vineyards are in South Australia, New South Wales, Victoria or Western Australia.

The regions in each of these states produce different wine varieties and styles that takes advantage of the particular terroir.

The major varieties of red grapes are Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot or Pinot Noir. Leading whites like Chardonnay, Semillon, Riesling, chenin Blanc or Sauvignon Blanc are dominant.

The South Australian wine industry is responsible for more than half of the production of wine in whole Country. The area produces a range of grape varieties from cool climate Riesling in Clare Valley to big, full-bodied Shiraz wines of Barossa Valley.

Some best-known wines like Penfolds Grange or Yalumba are made in Barossa. Shiraz wines produced in area are full-bodied, shows fleshy flavours of black fruits and pepper.

Mentioned Penfolds Grange is Australian's most famous. Well known wine critic wrote that "Grange has replaced Bordeaux's Petrus as World's most exotic and concentrated wine".

New Zealand wine growing regions are mostly located in the Valleys like Hawke's Bay, Martinborough, Nelson or Marlborough.

This country is the world's best known for the production of Sauvignon Blanc from Marlborough. Most wines made from this grape display the pungent, grassy green flavours that international wine community associate with New Zealand style. Produced unoaked, with aromas from green

apples, gooseberries or passion fruit. Other white grape varieties planted widely are Chardonnay and Riesling. Red wines, internationally well-known from New Zealand are french varieties.

The rising star from New Zealand is definitely Pinot Noir. The most common red grape on the Islands.

The wines made of this grape are fruit-driven, in particular red cherry. It tends to be quite full bodied. High quality examples are distinguished by savoury, earthy flavours with complexity and cellaring potential.

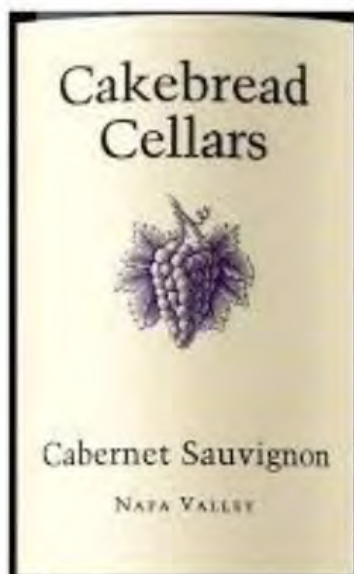
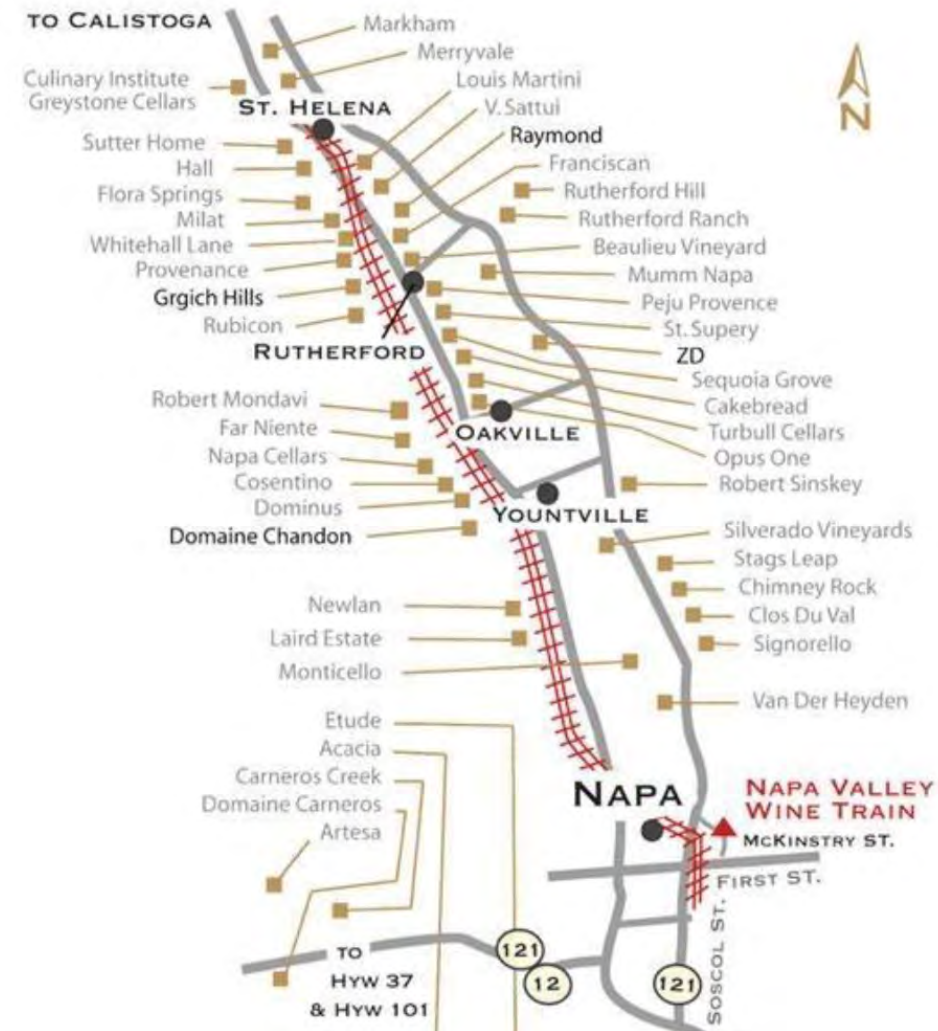
Napa valley in California introduced the world to the most famous wines from Northern America.

Red wines from Shiraz, Merlot and Pinotage grape varieties can be fresh and juicy or full-bodied and gusty. South African Sauvignon Blanc offers you an excellent alternative to the considerably more expensive counterparts from New Zealand.

Over twenty grape varieties are grown in Chile, mainly mixture of Spanish and French. Chilean winemakers have been developing a distinct style for their Cabernet Sauvignon, producing an easy drinking wine with soft tannins and flavours of mint, black currant, olives and smoke.

Other red varieties include Merlot, Carmenere or Pinot Noir are worth attention as white, Chardonnay or Sauvignon blanc are the most popular.

In past decades Argentina has evolved from from Country not well known on global wine scene to the New World's fastest growing exporter of wines. The leading grape in terms of reputation and quantity is Malbec. Wines made from this grape are characterized by deep colour and intense fruity flavours with velvety texture.

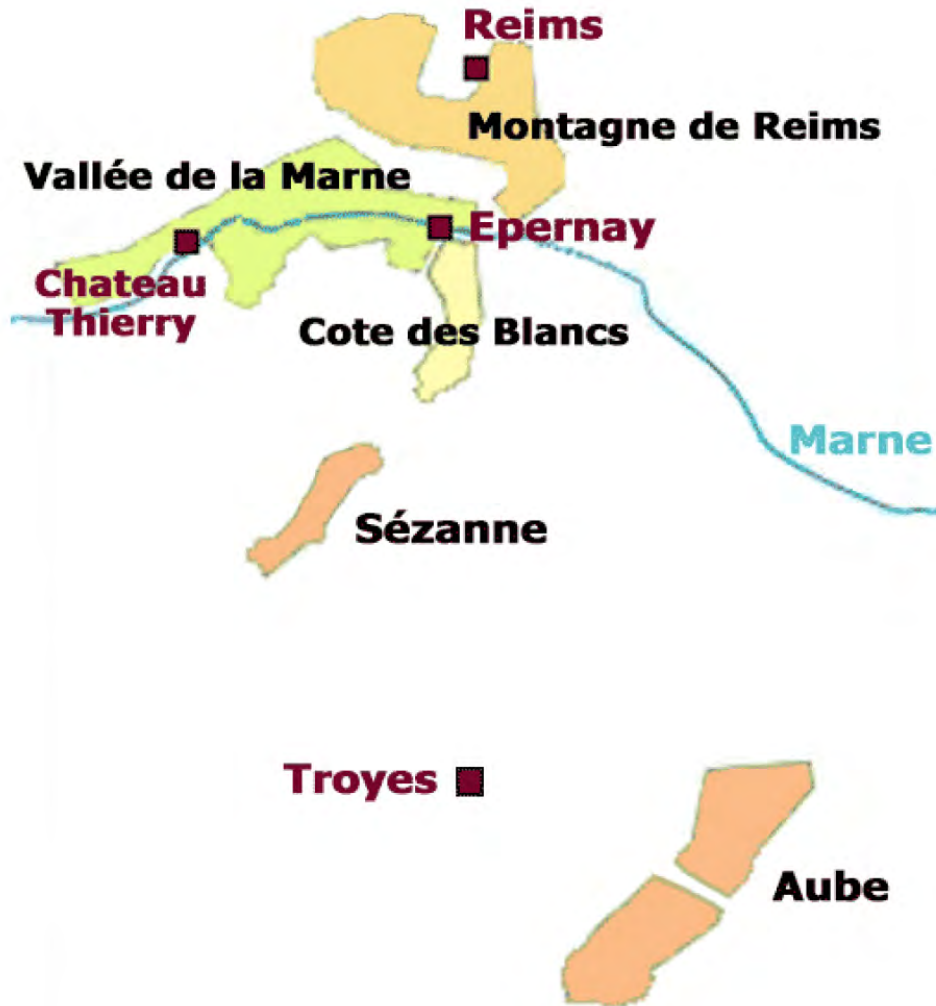

Champagne, the northern most wine region in France, produces the most celebrated sparkling wine in the world. Mainly made from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir varieties. In some, Pinot Meunier grape is added to blend. The most prestigious Champagne makers are located in the cities of Reims and Epernay.

The wines undergo a second fermentation in the bottle, producing carbon dioxide which dissolves in the wine under pressure. Through this method, Champagne acquires its crisp, long-lasting bubbles and distinctive yeasty, toasty dimension to its flavour.

Sparkling wine is made all around the globe but only in the Champagne region can be called "Champagne" by law.

The other world famous is Prosecco from Italy made from Glera grape. Spanish Cava is a good example too.
